### ***Fun Things to Do in Chattanooga***

*The easiest way to get around Downtown Chattanooga is to take **Chattanooga's Downtown Electric Shuttle** (CARTA). The buses run daily, every 15 minutes 6:30 am – 10:00 pm (Sundays 10-6) and are wheelchair accessible*

### ***Do you love the outdoors?***

**See Rock City** – Located atop Lookout Mountain, Rock City Gardens is just six miles from the Westin Chattanooga (17minute drive). Amazing natural rock formations create a unique landscape of gardens, caverns, and caves. Lover's Leap offers breathtaking views of the Tennessee Valley, from which you can see seven states! Enjoy outdoor dining & a glass of wine while soaking in the views as well. Open 8:30 am – 7:00 pm. Allow 1 ½ - 2 hours to explore. Rock City is partially handicap accessible. **Ruby Falls** – Journey deep inside Lookout Mountain to see the tallest and deepest underground waterfall open to the public in the United States. A 12-minute drive (less than five miles) from the Westin Chattanooga, Ruby Falls offers a 1 ½ hour guided walking tour 260 feet underground. Open 8:00 am – 8:00 pm. **Chickamauga & Chattanooga National Military Park** – The park is located in both Georgia & Tennessee and is operated by the National Park Service. The Chickamauga Battlefield Visitor Center is located in Fort Oglethorpe, GA (9.5 miles or a 19-minute drive from Westin Chattanooga) and is open daily 8:30 am – 5:00 pm. The Lookout Mountain Battlefield Visitor Center is located atop Lookout Mountain, TN (8 miles or an 18-minute drive from Westin Chattanooga) and is open daily 8:30 am – 5:00 pm. **Riverwalk** – This 13 mile walk along the banks of the Tennessee River offers paved paths that link to a variety of restaurants and activities, including the Hunter Museum. You can access Riverwalk from the Tennessee Aquarium. You can also rent a standard or e-bike to ride Riverwalk at Bike Chattanooga stations. Riverwalk is handicap accessible. **Tennessee Aquarium & IMAX Theater** – Trace the path of water from the mountains to the sea at the Tennessee Aquarium located half a mile from the Westin Chattanooga (4 minute

**Charles H. Coolidge National Medal of Honor Heritage Center** – Chattanooga is where our nation's highest military honor for valor was first awarded.
