Attire

Conference Registration Check-In

1. On Friday, you **MUST** come to the Legacy Lodge lobby first (before going to Game Changer) to check-in with our Conference Registration Check-In Team (*even if you don't have a hotel room*). Your registration materials will include your drink tickets and Game Changer game card. These items will **NOT** be available at Game Changer. Check-In opens at 4:00 PM.
2. On Saturday, the Conference Registration Check-In will be in the District Hub area (Veranda Room). Registration opens at 7:30 AM.
3. There will be no on-site registrations available. The Registration Check-In is for pre-registered Rotarians and guests only.

Meals

Meals are included with your conference registration fee. Meals are only for registered attendees.

Friday

- Friday night dinner will be buffet style at Game Changer starting at 7:00 PM.

Saturday

- 6:00 AM - 8:45 AM. - Morning buffet breakfast will be at your leisure located inside Sidney's Restaurant on the Lobby level of The Legacy Lodge or Bullfrog's Restaurant on the first floor. Advise your wait staff that you are with the Rotary District Conference and show your name badge. Tip is included.
- 12:00 PM – A boxed lunch will be provided at The Foundation Luncheon at the Legacy Pointe Pavilion.
- 6:30 PM - Plated dinner will be served at the Saturday night general session. If you did not indicate your meal preference or special dietary needs, you will receive the chicken dinner.
- An all-day break (snacks and beverages) will be provided in the Legacy Lodge.

Sunday

- 7:30 AM – 9:00 AM - A breakfast buffet will be provided. Feel free to eat in advance of the closing General Session or bring your breakfast to the session.

Transportation

Game Changer on Friday Night

There will be shuttles to take everyone to/from the Legacy Lodge and Game Changer from 5:30 PM – 9:30 PM. The shuttle will be located outside of the front lobby of the Legacy Lodge. There is limited parking at Game Changer. Attendees are encouraged to park at Legacy Lodge and take the shuttle to Game Changer.

Hospitality Suites on Friday and Saturday Nights

The Hospitality Suites will be in the Villas (*not the Legacy Lodge*). The Villas are within walking distance from the Legacy Lodge, however we will also have six golf carts that will be shuttling attendees from 8:45 PM to 11:15 PM. Pickup will be outside of The Legacy Lodge lobby.

Foundation Luncheon - Legacy Pointe Pavilion

The Saturday luncheon will be outside at the Legacy Pointe Pavilion, located just behind the hotel. There are several stairs to access the Pavilion, if you need assistance, we will have golf carts to shuttle you. Just see one of the Sergeant-At-Arms for assistance.

Game Changer

Friday night's activities will be at Game Changer. This is a night of fun and networking!

- Each attendee will receive two complimentary beverage tickets and a preloaded game card (NOTE: YOU MUST COME TO THE CONFERENCE REGISTRATION CHECK-IN LOCATED AT THE LEGACY LODGE L-BAR TO PICK UP YOUR MATERIALS. REGISTRATION MATERIALS WILL NOT BE AT GAME CHANGER). Your card will be loaded with 100 credits for the arcade games or you may exchange it for 30 minutes of Axe Throwing or one try at the Escape Room, subject to availability.
- Buffet dinner, starting at 7:00 PM, will be provided at Game Changer.
- There will be shuttles to and from Legacy Lodge and Game Changer. If you do drive, there is limited free parking.
